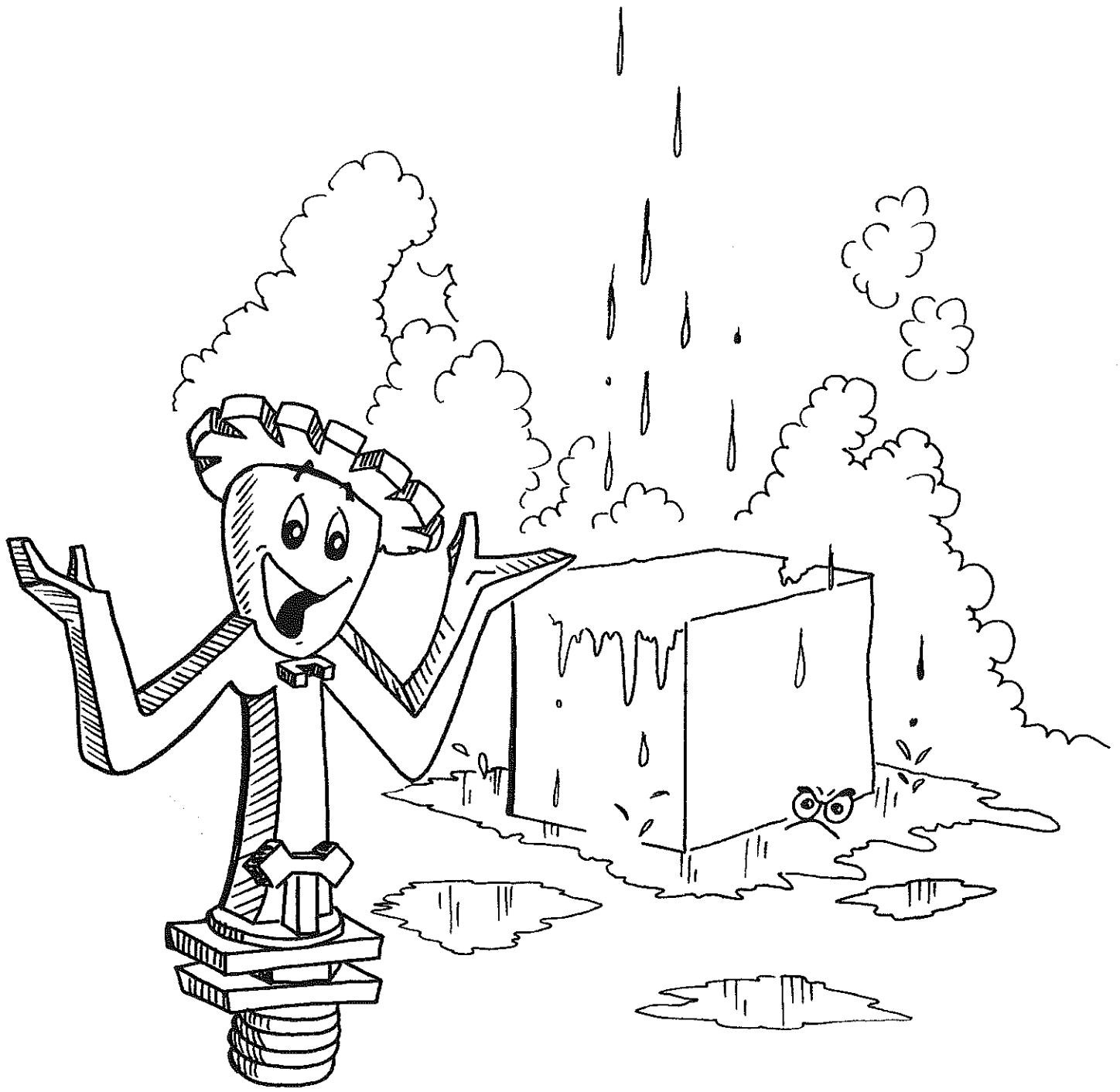
*"Hi, Kids. I came by to talk about fire

where they live, work, and play.*

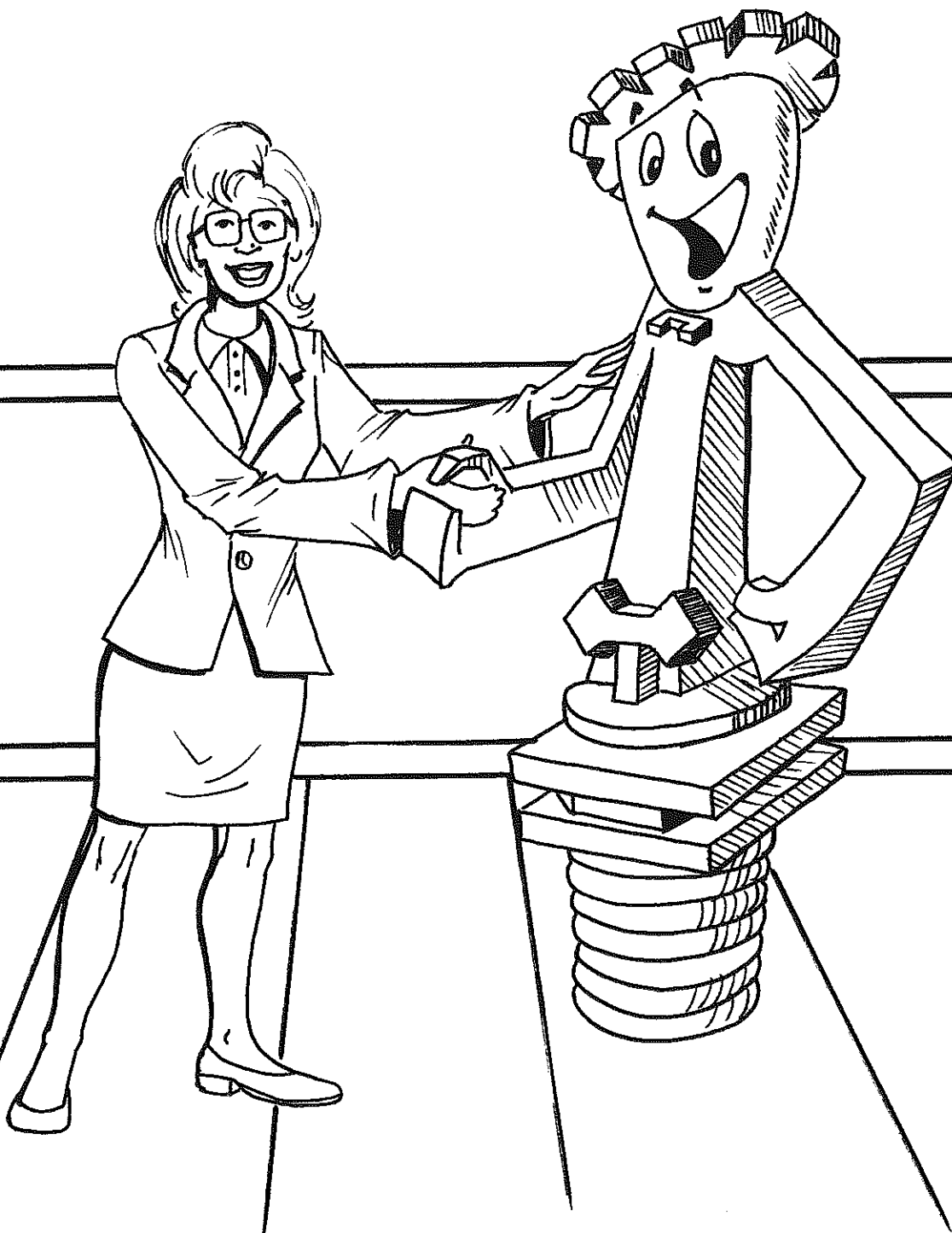


Sprinklers help the fire department put out fires.



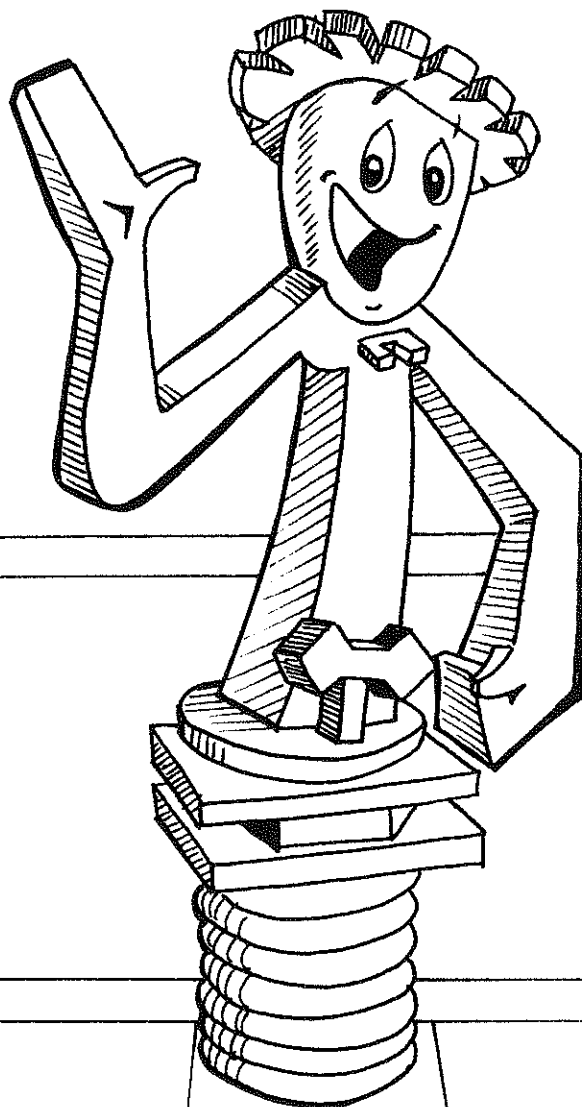
Sprinklers also keep the areas cooler so people can get out of the building safely.
